

**Cleburne County**

Cleburne County had a total population of 25,970 in 2010, making it the 26th most populous county in the state. It experienced an 8.0 percent increase in population from 2000. With a land area of 553.1 square miles, Cleburne County's population density increased from 43.5 persons per square mile in 2000 to 47.0 persons per square mile in 2010. The racial composition of the county was 96.8 percent White, 0.3 percent Black or African American, and 2.9 percent Other. Of the people living in Cleburne County, 2.0 percent were Hispanic or Latino, which can be of any race. The population age 18 and over accounted for 80.1 percent of the total population. There were a total of 15,826 housing units, of which 70.0 percent were occupied. The county seat of Cleburne County is Heber Springs. It had a 2010 population of 7,165, which reflects a growth of 11.4 percent since 2000.
