

**Woodruff County**

Woodruff County had a total population of 7,260 in 2010, making it the 74th most populous county in the state. It experienced a 16.9 percent decrease in population from 2000. With a land area of 586.6 square miles, Woodruff County's population density decreased from 14.9 persons per square mile in 2000 to 12.4 persons per square mile in 2010. The racial composition of the county was 69.9 percent White, 27.5 percent Black or African American, and 2.6 percent Other. Of the people living in Woodruff County, 1.2 percent were Hispanic or Latino, which can be of any race. The population age 18 and over accounted for 77.0 percent of the total population. There were a total of 3,893 housing units, of which 80.5 percent were occupied. The county seat of Woodruff County is Augusta. It had a 2010 population of 2,199, which reflects a decline of -17.5 percent since 2000.
