A Future Fund is a fresh and exciting approach to charitable giving. Its mission is to engage and provide today's young visionaries and leaders with a means to impact their community through the giving of their pooled resources, talents, and convictions.

The Hot Springs Future Fund was started in 2010 by the Hot Springs Area Community Foundation and inspired by the Future Fund in Greensboro, N.C.

Each year, new and current members pay membership dues based on their age and family status (see below). These dues are pooled together for the year. Half of all membership dues go towards an endowment producing annual income towards each year's grant cycle.

The other half goes directly to the current year's charitable grant giving account, and you join with the other current HSFF members to select which charitable organizations to support.

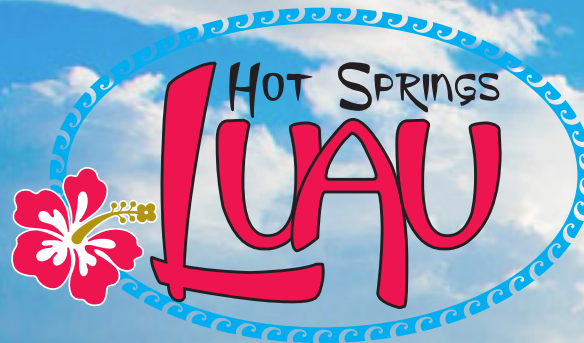

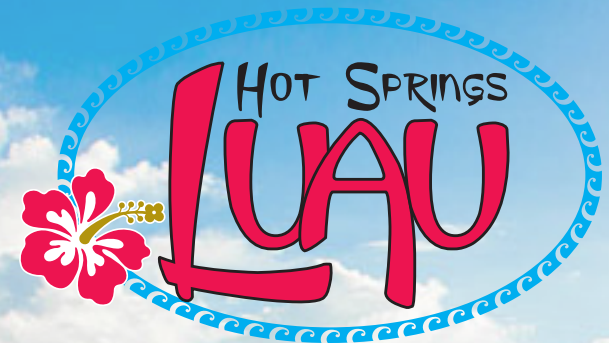
