



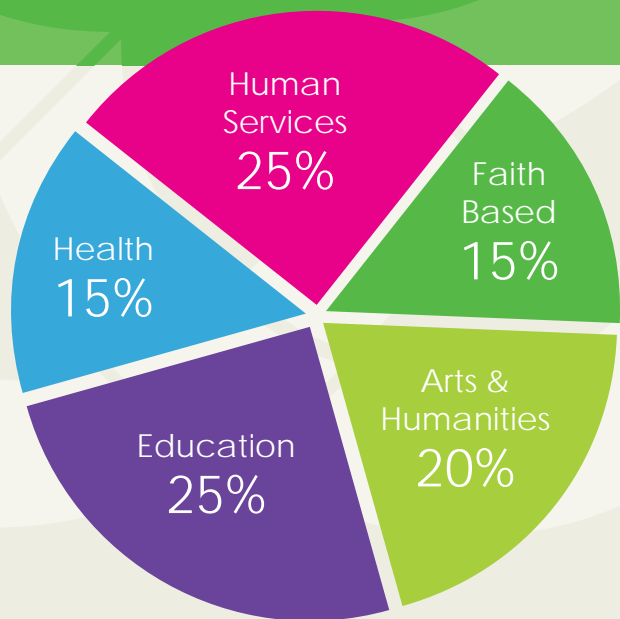
The Power of Endowment

Contributing to an endowment at Arkansas Community Foundation allows you to support the causes you care about long after you're gone. Endowments are permanently invested, and only a portion of the fund is used for grantmaking so the rest can be reinvested for the future. Gifts made to endowments snowball over time, creating a perpetual source of impact.

Consider this: A one-time donation to a nonprofit will be used to cover immediate needs. But by creating an endowment at the Community Foundation, you can support the nonprofit's immediate and long-term goals, along with other needs in your community, forever.
