

# Building Black Communities Fund

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*Arkansas Community Foundation*

## *Project Overview*

Arkansas Community Foundation, in partnership with the Arkansas Black Philanthropy Collaborative (ABPC), invites Black-led and Black-serving nonprofits to apply for the **Building Black Communities Fund**, which provides grants up to \$25,000 to support programs and initiatives specifically designed to impact Black people and communities in the Little Rock metropolitan statistical area, which includes Pulaski, Saline, Perry, Grant, Faulkner and Lonoke counties.

Financial support for the Building Black Communities Fund has generously been provided by Facebook, Inc. Grants will be administered by Arkansas Community Foundation.

### **Application & Deadline**

Applications with required information should be completed no later than May 15, 2021. Upon submission, please look for confirmation of receipt.

### **Level of Funding**

Grant requests up to \$25,000 will be competitively considered. Only one proposal per organization may be submitted.

### **Background**

Arkansas Community Foundation is one of 20 community foundations in the United States selected to receive funding from Facebook to manage grantmaking to support Black communities and Black-led nonprofits. This commitment is part of a broader \$1.1 billion investment from Facebook in Black and diverse suppliers and communities in the US. The specific activities that awardee organizations undertake as part of this initiative should be directed by their deep connection to, and understanding of, the unique needs and strengths in Black communities.

Proposals will be evaluated based on a specific, well-conceived work plan.

### **Eligibility Determination**

1. Applicant organizations must hold 501(c)(3) public charity status with the IRS.
2. Applicant organizations must be Black-led or Black serving, based on the following definitions:
  - a. Black-led: 51% or more of staff leadership, board and/or governing body are Black;
  - b. Black-serving: 75% or more of the population served consists of Black individuals in majority communities of color.

3. Applicants should be able to demonstrate established relationships and have a good track record of working on activities that impact Black communities.
4. Applicants must be based in or serve primarily the Little Rock metropolitan statistical area including the following counties: Pulaski, Faulkner, Grant, Lonoke, Perry, Saline.

### **Grant Requirements**

Grantees must commit to:

- Provide a brief final grant narrative and financial report with outcomes accomplished by the funded work.
- Document funded efforts, including the use of photography, video, and in written form.
- Participate in technical assistance activities and/or a networking group of grant recipients, and participate in grant status calls, if necessary.
- Expend all grant funds between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022.
