| Faulkner County | Faulkner | \$1,100 | Interested in Early Literacy and Food Security | Gives primary consideration to nonprofits based in Faulkner county |
| Fayetteville Area | Washington | \$500 - \$1500 | Focusing on children living in poverty and individuals living with disabilities in Washington County. | Gives primary consideration to nonprofits based in Washington county |
| Greene County | Greene | \$1000 - \$3500 | Accepting applications for Greene County 21st Century Women's Endowment | Does not award funding to organizations based outside of Greene County |
| Johnson County | Johnson | \$500 - \$2500 | Interested in any local charitable purpose related to family, health, education, community, early literacy, food security | Gives primary consideration to nonprofits based in Johnson county, but may consider nonprofits that demonstrate services provided to Johnson County. |
| Lee County | Lee | \$100 - \$1500 | Interested in any local charitable purpose | Does not award funding to organizations based outside of Lee County |
| North Delta | Randolph, Clay, Lawrence | \$250 - \$2000 | Interested in any local charitable purpose, Early Literacy, and Food Security | Gives primary consideration to nonprofits based in Clay, Lawrence and Randolph counties |
| Phillips County | Phillips | \$2500 - \$5000 | Interested in any local charitable purpose | Gives priority consideration to nonprofits based in Phillips County |
| Pope County | Pope | \$500 - \$2500 | Interested in any local charitable purpose | Gives priority consideration to nonprofits based in Pope County |
| Sharp County | Sharp | \$500 - \$3000 | Interested in any local charitable purpose | Gives priority consideration to nonprofits based in Sharp County or that provide considerable services in Sharp County. |
| SEAR | Ashley, Chicot | \$500 - \$3500 | Interested in any local charitable purpose | Does not award funding to organizations based outside of Ashley and Chicot counties |
